The Emergency Room is designed to take care of any known or potentially life-threatening medical condition or injury that risks death or disability without immediate medical intervention such as:

- Chest pain/discomfort, nausea, shortness of breath, severe headache, lightheadedness, fainting, uncontrolled high blood pressure
- Facial drooping, arm weakness, difficulty or trouble speaking, confusion, loss of vision, double vision, blurry vision, seizure
- Severe abdominal pain, coughing up blood, blood in your stool, fever
- Inhaled smoke or poisonous fumes, drug overdose, suicidal thoughts
- Electric shock, severe burns, allergic reaction, broken bones, trauma
- Severe back pain, wound infection, choking
